# 13DAY 11NIGHTEXPLORE BALKAN



# Day 01: Kuala Lumpur – Athens

(L/D)

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for flight to Athens transit via Frankfurt. Upon arrival, proceed to visit lycabettus Hill (Photo Stop). Later we visit to Syntagma Square which is the central square of Athens then later on we will visit Monastiraki, which means 'small monastery', means several things at once for you as a visitor and is an important destination in Athens. Transfer for lunch at restaurant. Then check in to hotel. (1400hrs) and rest of the afternoon is free at leisure. Dinner at restaurant and overnight stay at hotel.

Day - 02: Athens (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Today we will proceed for a Guided City Panoramic Tour of Athens. Combine the sights of modern Athens with sites of historical importance on a 3.5-hour tour by luxury coach. With an expert guide on hand to explain all the top Athens attraction, the tour passes Constitution Square and Panathenaic Stadium – home of the first mordent Olympic Games. Explore the Acropolis of Athens on food, and discover famous monument such as the Pantheon. Visit the Athens Acropolis Museum. Lunch at restaurant. Afternoon is free to explore Athens on your own or shopping. Dinner at restaurant. Overnight at Hotel.

### Day - 03: Athens - Kalambaka (350km-4h35min)

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, today we will proceed to Kalambaka. Lunch at restaurant upon arrival in Kalambaka. Then proceed for Guided City Tour of Kalambaka/Meteora and discover the astonishing Meteora through the eyes and the narrative of the locals. Visit 2 main monasteries Meteora and discover the natural beauty and the culture heritage of this area. Imagine that millions of tourists coming and going every year in Meteora and most of them will never learn or hear that just few km away from kalambaka and Meteora lays one of the most importance prehistoric caves not only to Greece but to the entire world, with archaeological findings dating back to 130,000 BC. Later visit to Theopetra prehistoric cave, (Admission Included) 5km from Kalambaka on the way to Trikala and discover the most ancient man made structure on earth, a stone wall dates back to 26,000 BC. Have the chance to see on the caves' floor the petrified footprints of a seven years old child that walked on the ashes some 60,000 year ago. Later proceed to Dinner at Restaurant. Check in hotel. Overnight at hotel.

# Day 04: Kalambaka – Ohrid (277km-3h 55min)

(B/L/D)

breakfast at hotel. Check Out and todays we will proceed to Ohrid. Arrive and Lunch at Restaurant. Take a Guided City Tour of Ohrid. Tour the city of Ohrid on the eastern shore of Lake Ohrid in the Macedonia This half day tour will take you through all the main sights of the UNESCO World Heritahe Site, one of only a handful inscribed both for their culture and natural

landscape. We will visit Hadzi Turgut Mosque, Krst Dazmija, Zeynel Abedin PashaTekke, Old bazaar. Dinner at restaurant. Overnight at hotel.

# Day 05: Ohrid - Tirana (136km-2h) - Budva (172km-3h)

(B/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Today morning we will proceed to Tirana. Proceed for walking Guided tour of Tirana including the visits of Ethem Bey Mosque, Clock Tower, the National Museum. Lunch at restaurant. Later we proceed to Budva. Arivvla at Budva and Dinner at restaurant. Overnight at hotel.

### Day 6: Budva – Dubrovnik (95km-2h5min)

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel and check out. Today morning we will do a Guided Panoramic City Tour of Budva. City tour will take you through old town Budva. After lunch. After lunch, proceed to Dubrovnik. Check in the hotel. The rest of the day free for shopping or experience Dubrovnik by youself. Dinner at hotel. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 7 : Dubrovnik (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Proceed for Guided City Panoramic Tour. Discover the best of Dubrovnik on a cobined tour of Dubrovnik's Old Town and ancient city walls. With your local guide, exploreDubrovnik's Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and see Orlando's Column, the City Bell Tower, the Rector's Palace and the Church of St Blaise. Then, explore the city ancient walls and see Fort Revelin and Minceta Tower. As you wander around Dubrovnik, learn the interesting history of this walled city from your knowledgeable local guide. Lunch at local restaurant. Free at leisure in the afternoon to explore this city. Back to hotel, dinner and overnight at hotel.

### Day 8: Dubrovnik - Mostar (140km-2h10min) - Sarajevo (126km-2h55min)

(B)

Breakfast at hotel. Check out the hotel. We drive to Mostar. Enroute we stop at kravice waterfalls; Pocitelj – old city fortress built during the Ottoman era; Blagaj – Buns Riverspring. Lunch at local restaurant. Continue driving at Mostar. Arrival in Mostar and proceed for a Guided City Tour of Mostar which includes visits of Karadjozbey mosque, Muslibegovic house walking through the old town and old bridge, listed as UNESCO heritage site. Later proceed to Sarajevo and check in.

Day 9 : Sarajevo (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, today we proceed with Half Day Guided Sightseeing Tour of Sarajevo which will included Vrelo Bosne – spring of river Bosnia, Tunnel museum – the only means of going in and out during the siege of Sarajevo in last war. Proceed to Bascarsija for a Walking guided tour in the old town with the visits of Latin bridge, lace where the Austro Hungarian Archduke Wasassassinated, what triggered the 1st World War; Brusabezistan – covered market place, Gazi Husref Bey Mosque, built in 1530 year during the Ottoman era – and Gazi Husref Bey Madrass; Moricahan built in 1551; Vijecnica – town hall for the Austro Hungarian era. Lunch at local restaurant. Free at leisure for exploring Sarajevo or shopping. Bank to hotel for dinner and overnight at hotel.

### Day 10: Sarajevo – Travnik – Banja Luka – Zagreb

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel and check out. Today we will proceed to Banja via Travnik. Panoramic City Tour of Travnik. This city has strong oriental culture. Excellent examples of Ottoman architecture are Elci Ibrahim Pasha's Madrasa and Colored (Sulejmania) Mosque (built 1575). Visit to the House of the internationally known local writer Ivo Andric – Nobel winner and the Travnik Fortress, most impressive fortress in central Bosnia and Herzegovina. Lunch at local restaurant. Later we proceed to Banka Luka. Banja Luka is the administrative capital of the Republika Srpska, the second largest city in bosnia and Herzegovina and by far largest city in the northwest. The Ottoman governor for Bosnia had his headquarters here for a while, building bridges and mills, and in its Ottoman glory days the town had some 40 mosques. In the course of the Ottoman centuries, Banja Luke was destroyed repeatedly by Ottoman-Austrian warfare (as well as earth quakes and plagues) until eventually the Austrian-Hugarian Empire absorbed Banja Luka peacefully in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. They rapidly modernized the town, building factories and connecting it to Vienna and other capital cities. The town expanded tremendously in the 20<sup>th</sup> century. Later check in the hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 11: ZAGREB (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Today we will have Half Day Guided Panoramic City Tour of Zagreb. The panoramic tour will show you the highlights of Zagreb's Lower Town. We'll be driving by the Mimara museum that hosts more that 3500 pieces of art collected by Ante and Wiltrud Topic Mimara, Museum of Arts and Crafts, 19<sup>th</sup> century neo-baroque building of Croatian National Theatre, and the head quarter of the biggest University in Croatia – Zagred University. Continuing ourdrive among Zagreb's Green Horseshoe, sequence of 8 connected parks and squares, you get a chance to see one the stations where famous Orient Express train used to stop at – Zagreb's main train station and the hotel built for its passengers – Hotel Esplanade. Just opposite of the

train station is the square named after first Croatian King with the statue of King Tomislav, and a breath taking Art Pavilion behind it. Then we will do a short walking tour where we visit the two historic settlements – kaptol and Gradec – from which Zagreb, as a capital city, developed. On kaptol you will not only learn about the biggest Cathedral in Croatia and Catholic Chuch but you will also get a change to discover our picturesque farmer's market Dolac. After crossing the border between the two hills, today the loveliest walking street in Zagreb, we will climb up to Gradec, better knows as Zagreb's Upper Town, and enter it through medieval Stone Gate. Inside of Gradec you will get a chance to see the seat of our countries administration, Parliament and Government building, as well as ST. Mark's Church with the famous colour roof, baroque church of St. Catharine's and 16<sup>th</sup> century Lotrscak tower. Final point of the touris Zagreb's main square – Ban Jelacic Square. Dinner at hotel. Overnight at hotel.

### DAY 12: ZAGREB – FRANKFURT – KUALA LUMPUR

(B)

Breakfast at hotel. Free at your own leisure until we proceed to Zagreb Airport for flight back to Kuala Lumpur via Frankfurt.
